BACKGROUND

As a part of the Bicentennial of the American Revolution, the federal government established programs encouraging each state to form Bicentennial Commissions. In Vermont we linked celebrations of the American Revolution with celebrations of the creation of the Republic of Vermont. The Vermont Bicentennial Commission was created on April 3, 1970 by Act #251. The Commission's purpose was, in part, "to plan and execute a program to commemorate properly the bicentennial of the founding of Vermont as a republic and the other historic events which are associated with the War of Independence."

Composition of the Commission was altered twice, by Act #45 (1973) and Act #143 (1974). The Commission's official existence continued through the end of 1977, though certain close-out activities, notably the preparation and publication of the Commission's final report, continued for some time after that.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The records of the Vermont Bicentennial Commission range from 1969 to 1979; the bulk dating from 1973-1977. The records thoroughly document the activities of the Commission. There is material on various Bicentennial projects and grants (including town bicentennial projects), transportation projects, the American Revolution Bicentennial Administration, material relating to the Vermont Bicentennial medallion, and sales correspondence. Included are copies of the Vermont Gazette and miscellaneous Vermont newsletters, newspaper clippings, photographs and memorabilia.

The finding aid consists of an inventory of all the records and a subject index which begins on page 65. The best way to access the records is to scan the list of series (pages 2-3) and to look at the index. The index is especially helpful because a particular subject may appear in many different spots.

The Vermont Bicentennial Commission records were transferred to the Secretary of State's office in early 1978, except for the financial records which arrived in October 1979. Robert Hagerman created an inventory of the Commission records in 1979. In 1993, the Archives staff disposed of some material appraised as non-archival (duplicates, invoices, bills and receipts, and Bicentennial material from other states). All of the records are on microfilm, except for the Bicentennial Memorabilia (Box 21) and the Bicentennial Photographs (Box 22). Audiovisual materials (including audiotapes, videocassettes, phonograph records, etc.) were transferred to the Vermont Historical Society in 1978 and 1980. For other information about the Commission and its activities, see the records of Governor Deane C. Davis and Governor Thomas P. Salmon at the State Archives.

All materials saved carry some response by the VBC. The correspondence saved (the balance was discarded) consists of a random sample of every tenth letter plus a number of additional letters specially selected (and not included in the random sample count) because of something particularly significant about the character of the incoming request and/or the VBC response in each case. The quantities of such special letters were: 1973, 3; 1974, 6; 1975, 40; and 1976, 10. It should be noted that in numerous cases these requests for information were referred to the VBC by other agencies and organizations which were the original recipients. They included the governor's office, the Vermont Agency of Development and Community Affairs or its Information and Travel Division, the Vermont State and Montpelier Chambers of Commerce, and one or another of Vermont's Congressional delegation.
